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1. Summary of Business Performance

(1) Overview of Current Period's Business Performance

In the current consolidated fiscal year, the global economy has been transitioning with a recovery trend as the restrictions on economic activities due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic have eased. However, uncertainties persist in the economic outlook due to ongoing geopolitical risks such as the prolonged Russia-Ukraine issue and escalating tensions in the Middle East.

In such an environment, our group announced in the Medium-term management plan on May 31, 2021, the management vision of 'Creating new value through transformation and aiming for sustainable growth by becoming a partner company for our customers. We have been progressing in the transition to a new business model, particularly by promoting the 'Takamiya Platform' to provide high-value-added services to Iq System purchasing customers announced on May 31, 2023.

We have been expanding functionalities such as the web-based interface 'OPERA' for all services provided on the 'Takamiya Platform' and the digital marketplace 'Iq-Bid' that allows free purchase and sale of construction temporary equipment. Additionally, the user account base for the operation management service 'OPE-MANE' of the main service, Iq System, has also increased.

As a result, the business performance for the current consolidated fiscal year amounted to Net sales of 44,127 million yen (an increase of 5.3% compared to the previous year), Operating income of 3,404 million yen (an increase of 51.1% compared to the previous year), Ordinary income of 3,580 million yen (an increase of 49.1% compared to the previous year), and Profit attributable to owners of parent of 1,887 million yen (an increase of 29.3% compared to the previous year).

The business performance by segment is as follows.

(Sales business)

In the temporary equipment division, there was considerable interest in the 'Takamiya Platform,' and while there were inquiries for new procurement, replacements, and additional purchase projects, concerns over soaring material prices, labor shortages, and uncertainties such as construction delays due to the postponement of purchase timing were raised, including the Bank of Japan's reduction in monetary easing. As a result, sales remained sluggish. On the other hand, with the proliferation of the 'Takamiya Platform,' high-value-added services such as 'OPE-MANE' were well-received, leading to an increase in transaction prices for construction temporary equipment on the 'Takamiya Platform,' contributing to an improvement in profit margins.

Outside of the temporary equipment division, sales in solar-related materials saw a decrease as large-scale solar projects that had been ongoing since the previous period reached completion.

As a result of these factors, Net sales amounted to 12,597 million yen (a decrease of 4.3% compared to the previous year) and Operating income reached 1,701 million yen (an increase of 43.0% compared to the previous year)."

(Rental Business)

In the construction sector, rental demand remained high, particularly in the maintenance and repair works in the Greater Tokyo Area, while rental demand also increased in the civil engineering sector due to a recent uptick in site activities. As a result, the rental volume of construction temporary equipment continued at a high level surpassing the previous period. Additionally, we expanded our equipment lineup and worked on further efficiency improvements in the operation of construction temporary equipment at equipment bases such as Takamiya Lab.West, as well as ensuring a stable supply system for 'Takamiya Platform' users.

These efforts led to sales of 28,214 million yen (an increase of 14.2% compared to the previous year) and operating income of 3,691 million yen (an increase of 41.4% compared to the previous year)."

(Overseas Business)

In the manufacturing sector, there were no significant impacts on the procurement of raw materials and parts, and shipments of construction temporary equipment to Japan from HORY VIETNAM (Vietnam) and Hory Korea (South Korea) remained strong.

In Hory Korea, which has an overseas sales department, concerns about the global economic downturn led to a similar trend in rental usage as seen in Japan within the temporary facilities division. Additionally, sales of solar-related materials decreased outside of the temporary facilities division, resulting in a decrease in sales revenue.

At DIMENSION-ALL INC. (Philippines), although economic activities showed signs of recovery, changes in project timelines due to reassessments of large-scale projects resulted in lower sales compared to the previous period.

As a result of these factors, sales amounted to 7,897 million yen (a decrease of 12.1% compared to the previous year) and operating income reached 320 million yen (a decrease of 20.7% compared to the previous year)."

(2) Summary of the Current Fiscal Period's Financial Condition

At the end of the current consolidated fiscal year, total assets amounted to 68,945 million yen, representing an increase of 6,195 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. The main factors contributing to this increase were a decrease in cash and deposits of 510 million yen, an increase in notes receivable of 946 million yen, an increase in merchandise and finished goods of 951 million yen, an increase in leased assets (net amount) of 3,890 million yen, and an increase in land of 1,292 million yen, among others.

Total liabilities amounted to 46,787 million yen, representing an increase of 4,560 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. The main factors contributing to this increase were an increase in bonds (including current portion of bonds) of 1,312 million yen and an increase in long-term loans payable (including current portion of long-term loans payable) of 2,531 million yen, among others.

Total net assets amounted to 22,157 million yen, representing an increase of 1,635 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. The main factors contributing to this increase were an increase in retained earnings of 1,374 million yen, among others.

(3) Summary of cash flows for the current fiscal year

The cash and cash equivalents at the end of the current consolidated fiscal year decreased by 308 million yen compared to the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year, amounting to 7,460 million yen (a decrease of 4.0% compared to the previous year).

The status and factors of each cash flow are as follows.

(Cash flows from operating activities)

The cash flow from operating activities resulted in an expenditure of 180 million yen (compared to an expenditure of 14 million yen in the previous consolidated fiscal year). This is mainly due to Profit before income taxes of 3,186 million yen, depreciation of 5,430 million yen, Purchase of assets for rent of 1,634 million yen, Decrease (increase) in inventories of 6,398 million yen. (Cash flows from investing activities)

The cash flow from investment activities resulted in an expenditure of 3,187 million yen (compared to an expenditure of 1,205 million yen in the previous consolidated fiscal year). This is mainly due to Purchase of property, plant and equipment of 3,416 million yen. (Cash flows from financing activities)

The cash flow from financing activities resulted in an income of 2,798 million yen (compared to an income of 398 million yen in the previous consolidated fiscal year). This is mainly due to Proceeds from long-term loans payable of 8,500 million yen, Repayments of long-term loans payable of 5,971 million yen.

(4) Outlook for the Future

In the future outlook, our group's major trading partner, the construction industry, may face challenges such as the 2024 labor hour restriction issue, rising construction costs due to increased resource prices, high crude oil prices, and energy price hikes, as well as potential impacts from the Bank of Japan's policy review leading to higher interest rates. Concerns such as global inflation and economic slowdown could pose uncertainties and continue to create an opaque economic environment.

Domestically, the construction investment sector is experiencing delays and postponements in projects due to high oil prices, increased construction material costs, and a shortage of skilled labor. However, there is stability seen in nationwide infrastructure improvement projects driven by initiatives like the National Resilience Plan. There's also a steady demand for warehouses and logistics facilities, coupled with plans for new semiconductor factories and data center construction due to the proliferation of AI, indicating robust movement in private-sector facility investments.

Considering these conditions, our company has developed a new medium-term management plan starting from the fiscal year ending March 2025, focusing on the platform business to address challenges in the construction and temporary facilities industries and reform our revenue base. Going forward, we will actively enhance the convenience of the platform through equipment base (logistics hub) and service reinforcement, alongside promoting digital transformation (DX) for improved management efficiency, aiming for increased users and revenue. Additionally, we will invest in human capital by revising starting salaries and personnel systems to promote DX and value-added creation, thus strengthening our management foundation.

In our overseas business, we anticipate a continued challenging environment due to local subsidiary dynamics. However, we have seen some improvement in segment business profitability trends, indicating progress in rebuilding our management foundation. Going forward, we will continue to focus on enhancing and expanding our business infrastructure to steadily improve profitability.

As a result, our group anticipates increased investment for Takamiya Platform development and expanded human capital investment, leading to increased depreciation and cost burdens, making significant profit improvement challenging. As part of our commitment to strengthening our management approach focusing on capital costs and share prices, each department and affiliated company within our group will set KPIs and implement specific actions toward achieving targets, balancing both business income and asset efficiency to achieve future revenue while transitioning to a resilient corporate structure capable of consistently generating profits.

Through these activities, we expect our consolidated performance for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2025 to achieve net sales of 49,500 million yen, operating income of 3,600 million yen, ordinary income of 3,220 million yen, and Profit attributable to owners of parent of 2,000 million yen.

2. Fundamental Principles for Selecting Accounting Standards

Our group policy is to prepare consolidated financial statements using Japanese standards, taking into account the comparability of financial statements over periods and comparability between companies.

Regarding the application of international accounting standards, we intend to appropriately respond after considering domestic and international circumstances.

Our group consists of three reporting segments: the Sales Business, which focuses on the manufacture and sale of construction temporary equipment, the Rental Business, which focuses on renting construction temporary equipment, and the Overseas Business, which focuses on the sale and rental of construction temporary equipment overseas.

2. Calculation Method for Revenue, Profit, or Loss by Reporting Segment

The accounting treatment of the reported business segments follows the accounting policies adopted to prepare the consolidated financial statements.

The profit of the reporting segments is based on operating profit.

Internal revenues and transfers between segments are based on market prices.

Assets are not allocated to business segments, but depreciation expenses are allocated.
